

# Netlang Cloud Security

When creating an account at Netlang.com a set of management and configuration information will be stored. This allows the user to get centralized control and distribution of integration configurations from any location even when a specific Gateway is down.

The following table lists all stored information in the Netlang Cloud.

- Account information
  - Basic information about the company, entered at the Company pages.
  - Billing information, such as invoices, addresses and VAT codes.
  - Netlang User accounts
    - Passwords are hashed and unable to decrypt.
- Integration configurations
  - Process definitions.
  - Script definitions.
  - Resources configuration such as login information are stored encrypted with a secret key unique to your company account.
- Runtime statuses
  - Netlang Gateway status such as up/down, IP-address, operation system information.
  - Log events created by the user within the integration.
  - Execution statistics.
  - Errors and stack traces
  - Notifications

It is important to note that no customer data that are being processed by a on-premises Gateway is stored in the Netlang Cloud. If the user does not explicitly build the integration to do that.
